Rashtrakutas (Administration)

The system of administration in these empires was based upon the ideas and practices of Gupta empire

King was head of administration and commander in chief of the armed forces

He also dispensed justice

The king was assisted by number of ministers

generally from leading families and their position was hereditary

The empires consisted of areas administered directly and areas ruled by vessels

Vessels had autonomy in internal affairs

He was in charge of maintaining law and order, collecting taxes, and keeping accounting records.

ADMINISTRATION

The directly administered territories were divided into

The head of Rashtra was Rashtrapati

and had both civil and military authority over the Rashtra

Rashtra (province)

Visaya (Districts)

Bhukti

Each Bhuktis was made up of a number of villages

Villages had committees to manage schools, tanks, temples etc

The popular representative council played an important role in village administration. The councils had representatives from each household.

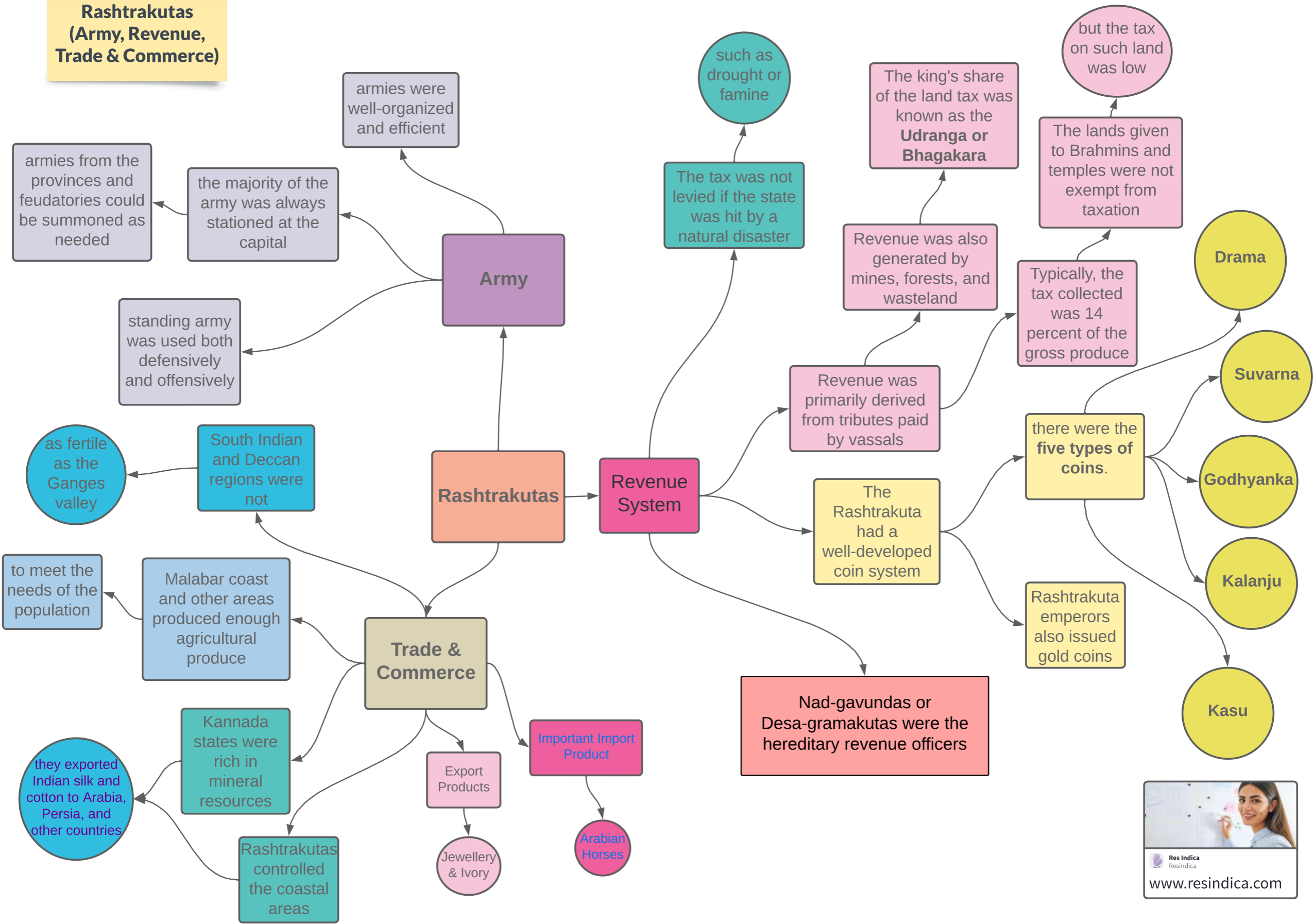
Law and order in the towns and in areas in their vicinity

the responsibility of Koshtapala or Kotwal

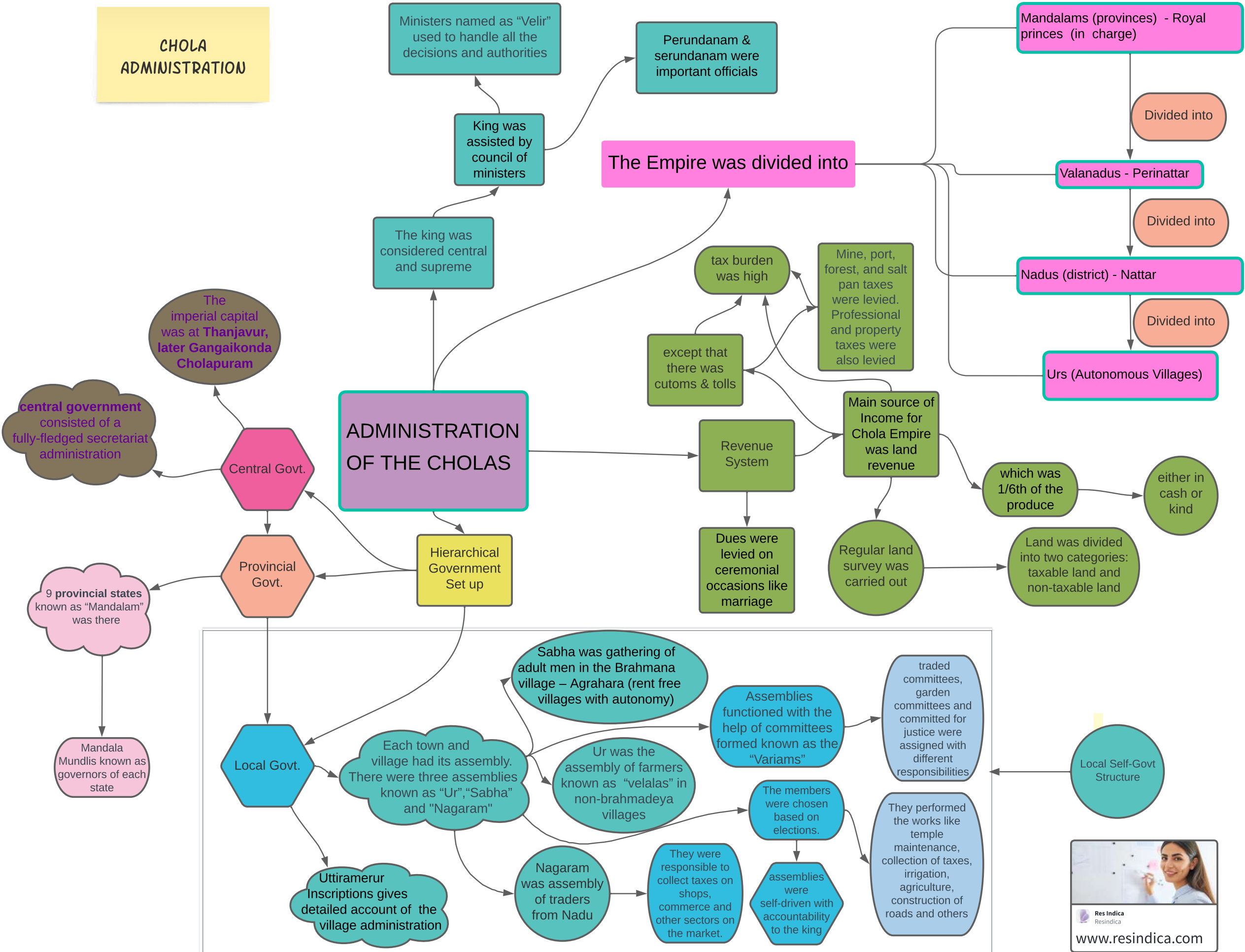
The village headman carried out duties with the help of Grama-Mahajana or Grama-Mahattara (village elders)

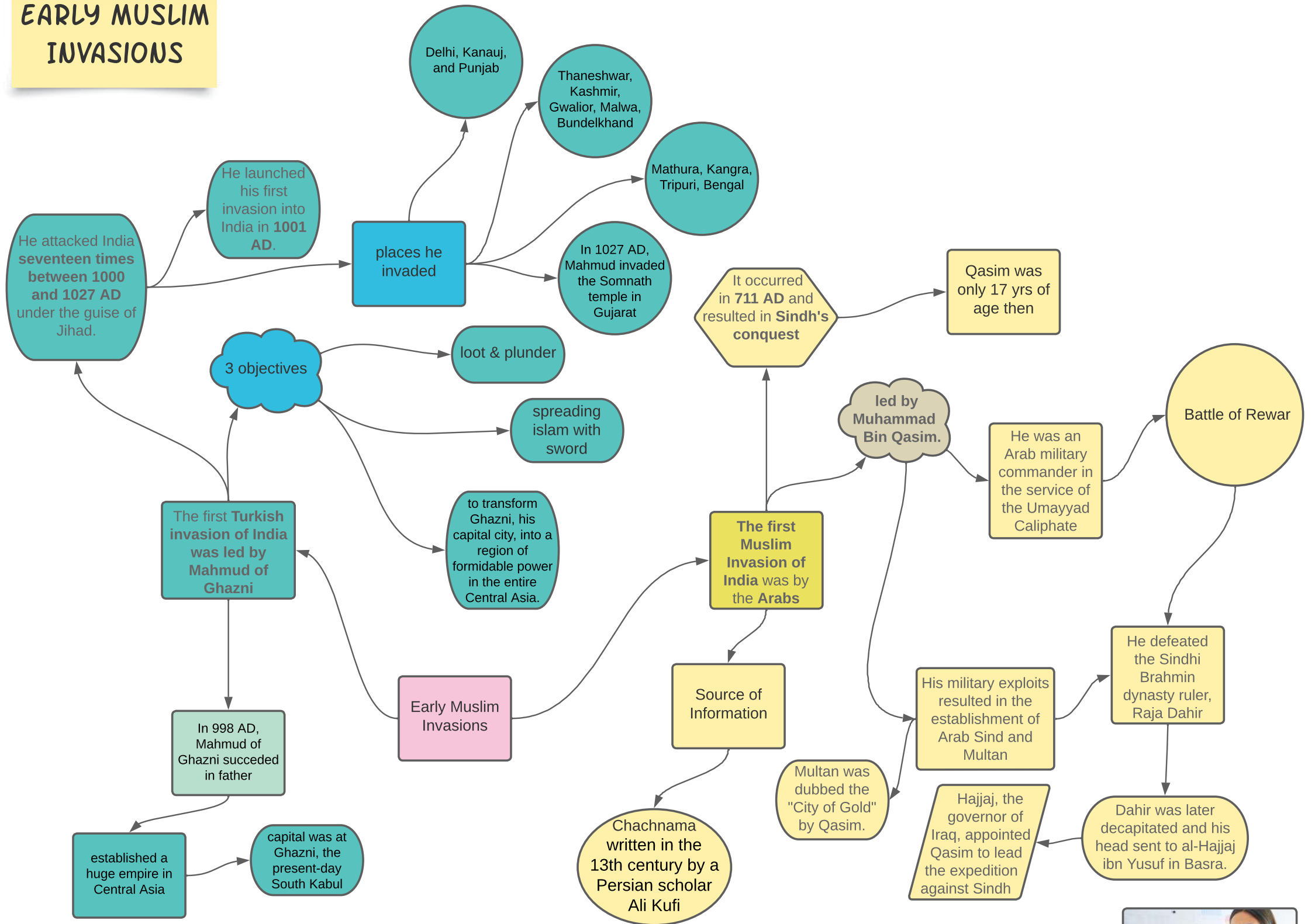
