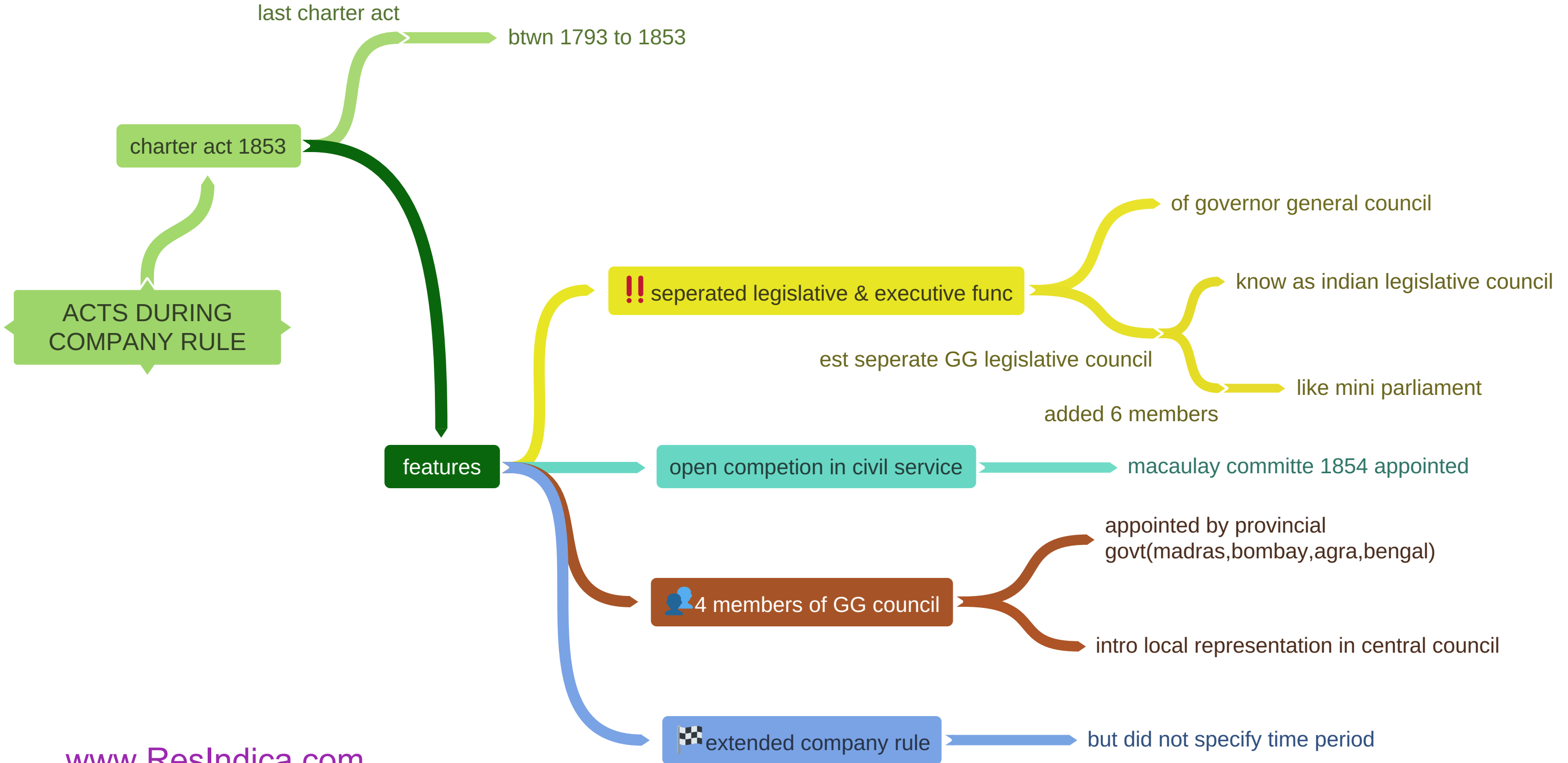
Adoption of Constitution, 26th November 1949

Constitution came into effect, 26th January 1950



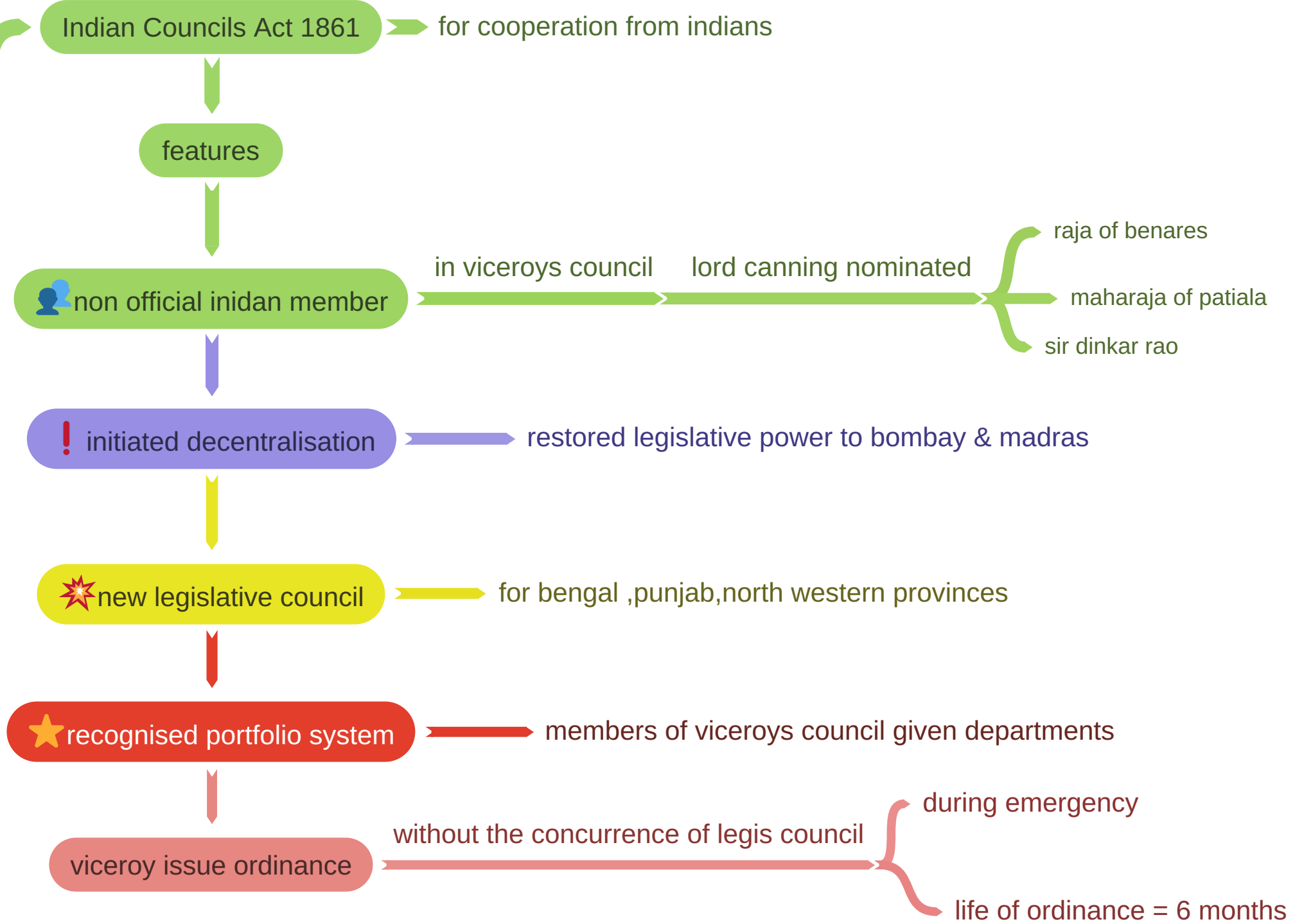


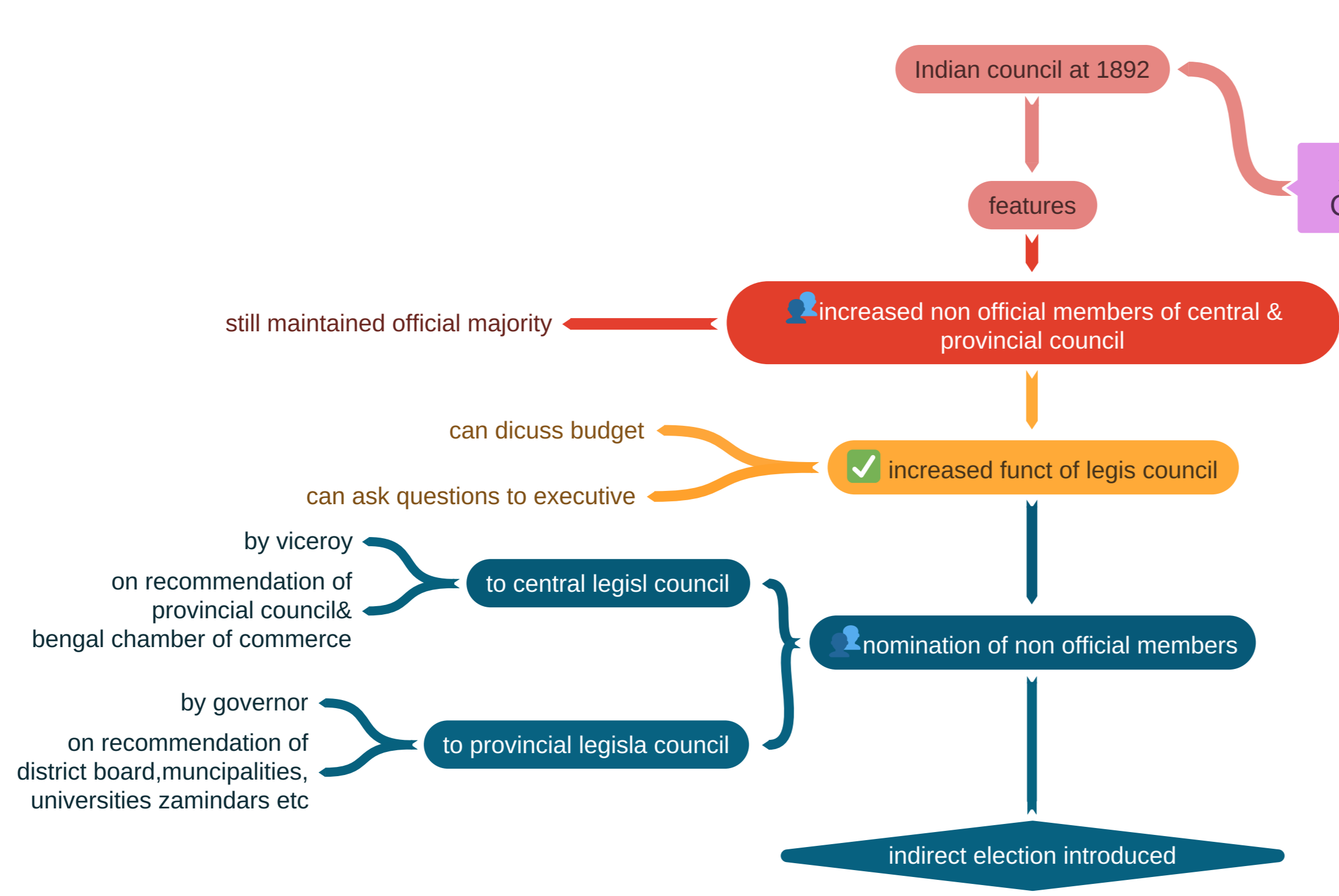






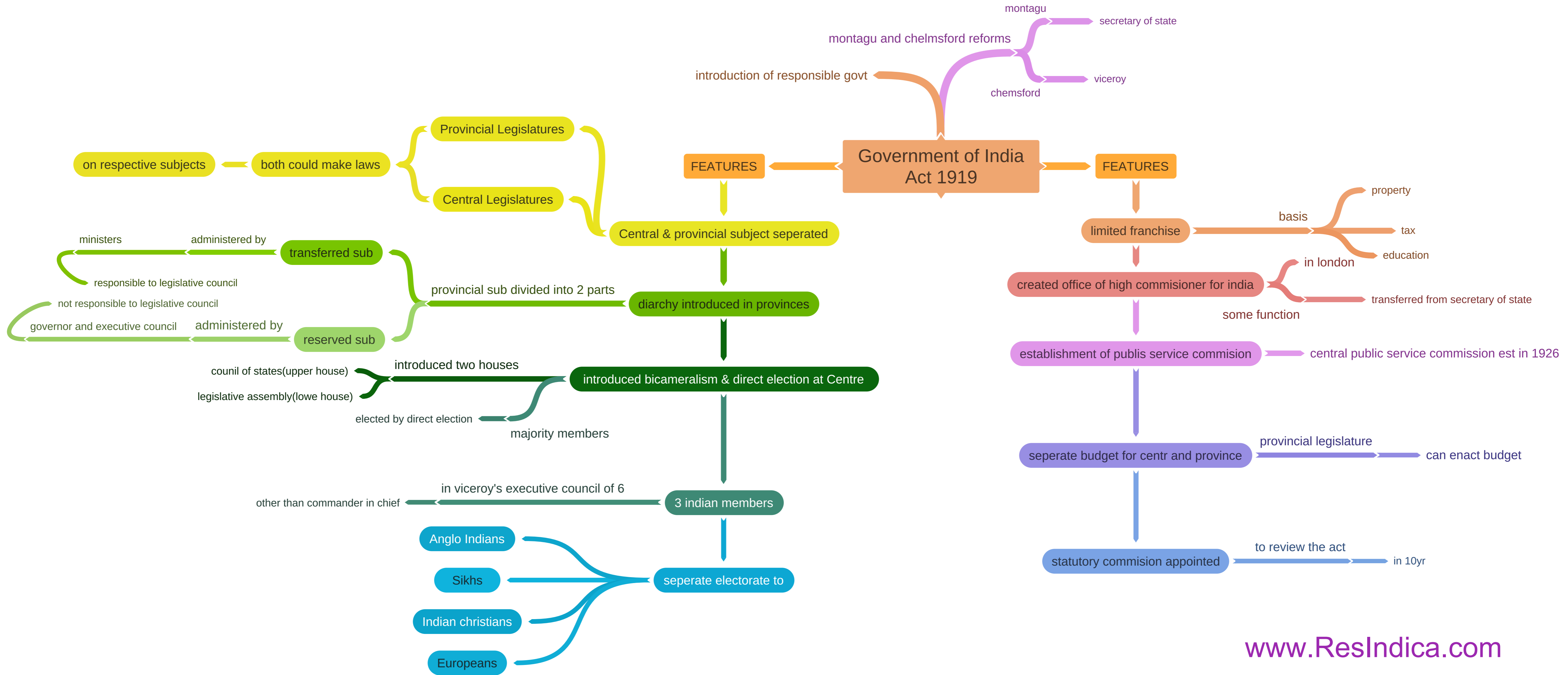
ACTS DURING CROWN RULE (1858-1947)

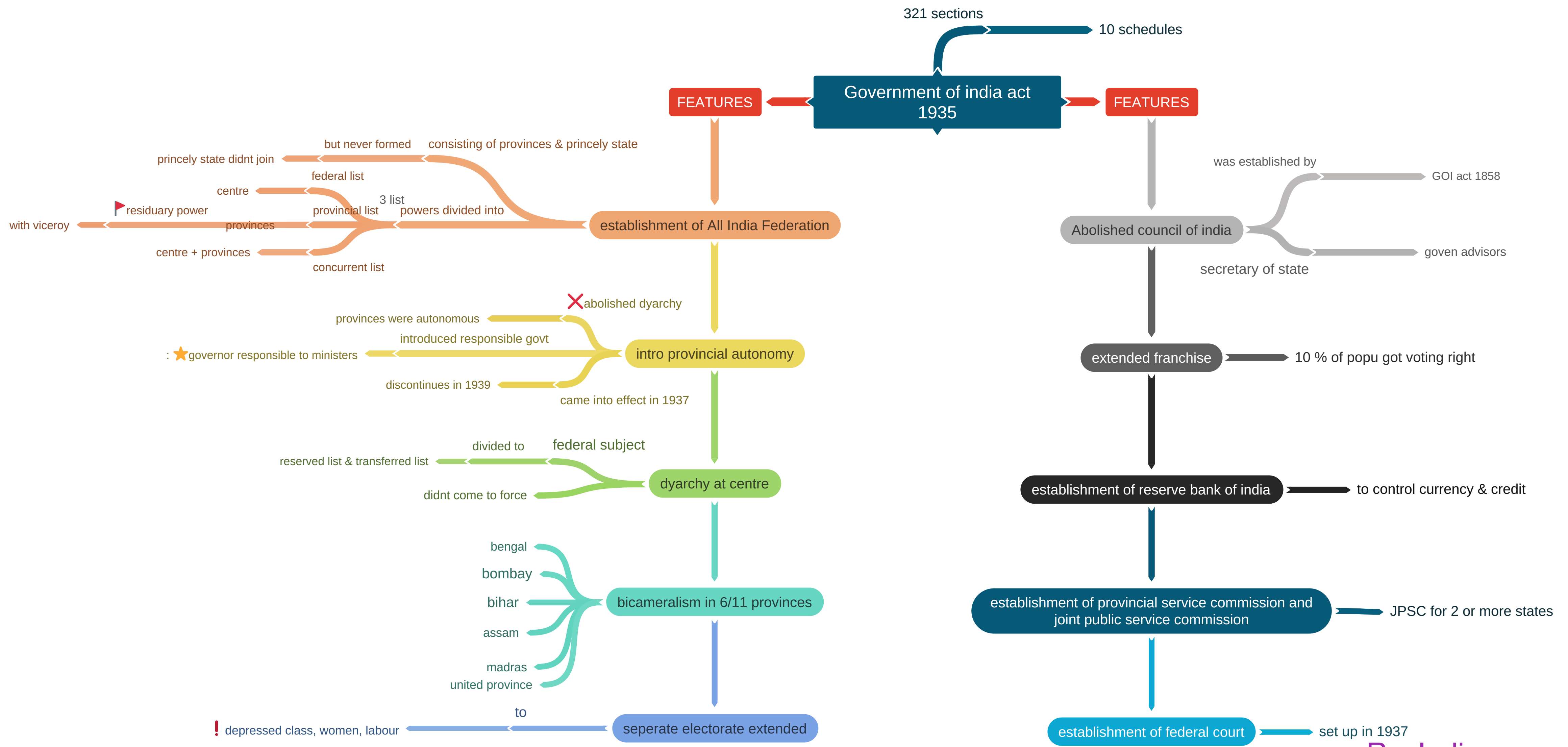

FEATURES

India became independent & sovereign
ended British rule
from aug 15, 1947

princely state can decide
dominion of india
dominion of pakistan
remain independent

partition of india
India created 2 independent dominion
Pakistan
both have rights
secede from British common wealth

continuation of GOI act 1935
dominions can make modification
till new constitution framed

governor general for each dominion
abolished office of viceroy
by british king appointment
on advise of dominion cabinet

monarch lost right to veto bill
and to reserve certain bill for his approval
right was reserved to governor general

constituent assembly of dominions can make constitution
can repeal
constituent assembly
important act of British parliament
even the independent act

governor general & provincial general made the constitutional head
act on the advise of council of ministers

abolished secretary of state
transferred funct to
secretary of state for common wealth affairs

dropped the title of emperor of India

lapse of paramountcy over princely state
lapse of treaty relation
with tribal area

discontinued appointment & reservation to civil service
by secretary of state for india
